How it Works

About Abilities Group

At Abilities Group we're a recycling charity with a heart for people with disabilities. Our aim is to enrich the lives of intellectually disabled people and those with learning disabilities by offering them fulfilling work opportunities in a safe, secure and caring environment. Our disabled employees require special support and are unable to find employment in open environment. We provide them with consistent employment assisted by a team of abled bodied support staff who work alongside them

We provide recycling services across Auckland and parts of the Waikato. This includes retail customers and corporate clients across all suburbs of Auckland. Corporate clients range from some of New Zealand's largest organisations to many small Kiwi businesses. In addition, we support community groups, schools, churches, non for profits and charities to assist them with their recycling efforts. We recycle e-waste, polystyrene, confidential documents, cardboard and soft plastic.

We currently employ over 100+ disabled staff, who are supported by 30+ non disabled employees. With 25% of our workforce being able bodied we believe this creates a more natural and balanced workplace. Our aim is to maintain the volume of employment opportunities for disabled staff in a sustainable way. Each year our team recycle over 1000 tonnes of waste that would otherwise end up in landfill.

What we have Achieved

\$3.7 million	Revenue in FY25	144 thousand	Hours worked by disabled staff in FY25
1,028 tonnes	Waste recycled in FY25 and diverted from landfill	6 weeks	to be fully operational after the fire that destroyed our premises in 2025.
